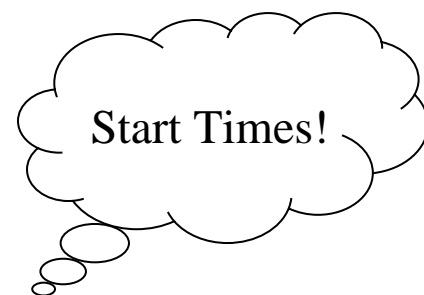

## SALEM COUNTRY CLUB JUNIOR GOLF

1. Instruction and drills will be given from 8:00am to 9:00am for golfers aged 11, 12, and 13 years old. At 9:00am golfers will be encouraged to compete on the course. The course will be open to play from 9:00am to 11:30am and parents may pick up their young golfers for transport home at anytime.
2. Juniors aged 7, 8, 9, and 10 years old will meet be given instruction from 9:00am to 10:00am. The course will be open from 10:00am to 11:30 am for your golfers to gain experience on the course. Juniors must be supervised by an adult on the course. Golf carts will be provided at no additional cost to parents wishing to take young golfers on the course.
3. The directors, members of the Salem High School Wildcat Golf Teams, and a few SCHS alumni who are now playing in college will be on hand to help instruct the junior golfers.
4. The Junior Golf Directors encourage parents to take young golfers on the course after instruction each week. Brief instruction on etiquette, course maintenance and technique will be provided for parents each week to assist them on the course.
5. We request that junior golfers be picked up no later than 11:45 am. We do not encourage Wednesday afternoon play unless the juniors are not only members but advanced golfers.
6. ETIQUETTE is an important part of golf. We will teach your child proper etiquette and we encourage all parents to reinforce it whenever possible.
7. Golf is a difficult sport and if you wish to succeed, self determination, dedication, and practice are a must!
